

Set Up Backups Using Backblaze

Install the Backblaze Backup client on a residential machine

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We use Backblaze for all residential backup services. All billing goes through Backblaze directly so you will need to enter your card card. At the time of writing this article, Backblaze costs **\$70 / year** for unlimited storage space.

To set up the backup software:

1. Visit this link to set up the software on your machine (this is our affiliate link):

2. Once you set up the account and credit card information the client software will download.
3. Install the software and it should start backing up everything automatically. You can review the exclusions in the program if you do not want to back up specific folders, otherwise you shouldn't have to specify anything.
